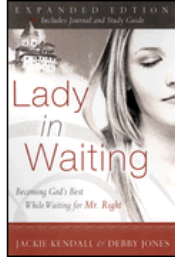


## BIBLE STUDY

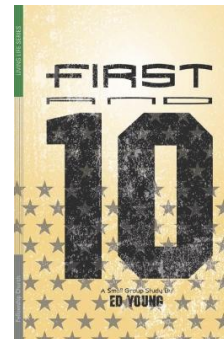

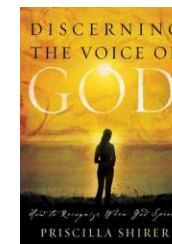

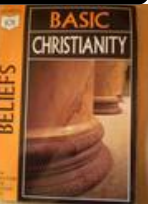
